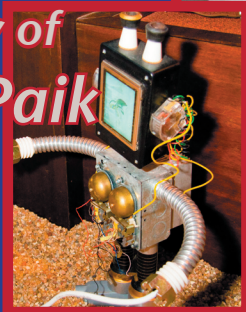

It's All FREE!



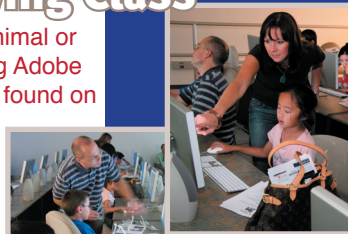

Art & Craft Projects

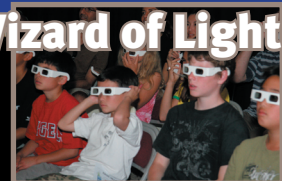
Take your Art Home!
